Corfu Imperial's consistent work towards a sustainable hotel management has been recognised by Travelife when it was awarded a **Travelife Gold** in 2014 -2016 for its dedication to the environment and sustainable tourism. Travelife Gold sustainability certification is awarded to hotels that have proven that environmental, social and governance (ESG) issues are embedded into their practices.

Grecotel has a long history of commitment to the environment and has been a pioneer in implementing sustainable measures throughout its hotels and resorts. Since 2009, Grecotel Hotels & Resorts have been collaborating with Travelife and have received a total of **26 Travelife Gold and Silver awards** spanning 16 of its properties.

As early as 1992, Grecotel management understood the importance of measuring its impact on the local environment and setting targets to lessen that impact. Environmental Management Systems procedures have been in place in Grecotel hotels & resorts since the onset of their CSR programme, and health & safety procedures have been in place since the establishment of the first hotel 40 years ago. These programmes which were based on setting realistic goals according to the local environment where each hotel is located would become a prototype for resort hotels throughout the Mediterranean and have won many international awards.

Grecotel continuously strives to be a leader in its commitment to sustainable tourism best practices and the successful integration of the UN Sustainable Development Goals into its priorities.
