Delivery of humanitarian aid for the earthquake victims of Turkey - Syria to Humanity Greece by the N. Daskalantonakis Group – Grecotel.



As part of the daily humanitarian work, Humanity Greece in view of the deadly earthquake in Turkey and Syria is collecting humanitarian aid for the earthquake victims, at Humanity Greece from Tuesday, February 7, to Tuesday, February 14. The N. Daskalantonakis Group – Grecotel immediately responded to our initiative by sending 3 pallets of emergency survival items for our fellow human beings.

All items are collected at the 1st Voluntary Coordination Center of the country, Millerou 76 Metaxourgeio, while the missions to the earthquake affected areas are carried out in collaboration with the Greek Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Taking into consideration the growing needs of the citizens to which Humanity Greece responds, with the contribution of its volunteers, the Volunteer Coordination Center created by new volunteers of Humanity Greece, stores, collects and sorts the goods before sending them on to where it is considered necessary. On a weekly basis, it holistically supports families from affected areas as well as families belonging to socially vulnerable groups in the country, by sending support packages that include from long-lasting food and baby products to personal hygiene products.
